INTRODUCTION

What you hold in your hand is a tool, a weapon, actually. It is the Word of God that has simply been formatted in a way that we hope will help you and encourage you to pray the Word of God over your loved ones. We are told in Ephesians 6:17 to "take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God." We must become skillful with this weapon so that we can utilize it effectively.
