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INTRODUCTION

What you hold in your hand is a tool, a weapon, actually. It is the Word of God that has simply been formatted in a way that we hope will help you and encourage you to pray the Word of God over your loved ones. We are told in Ephesians 6:17 to “take the helmet of salvation, and **the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.**” We must become skillful with this weapon so that we can utilize it effectively. We are also told in Hebrews 4:12 that “**the Word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword**, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.” Not only are we meant to use the Word of God as a sword to fight on behalf of those that have been entrusted to us, but as we do so, it will bring clarity, focus, and discernment to our intercession. You have been purposely positioned in your family for this season. The enemy would like to have his way with your precious ones, but as you step into your position of authority, satan’s flaming arrows, accusations, and plans to kill, steal, and destroy will be stopped. James 5:16 reminds us that “**The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.**” You were born for this season.
